2018 Prize for Scientific Excellence in Medicine

Dear Sir or Madame,

the American-Italian Cancer Foundation (AICF) invites you to nominate a candidate for the 2018 **Prize for Scientific Excellence in Medicine**. The Prize has been established to recognize important discoveries in cancer biology, prevention, diagnosis and/or treatment. Two awardees will be selected and each presented with a \$50,000 prize at AICF's annual Benefit Dinner & Auctions in New York on November 7, 2018. The Prize winners are then required to give a lecture on their research at a symposium which is held the day following the Benefit.

The nomination form can be found here. Each submission should include:

- A brief description of the discovery or discoveries on which the nomination is based (500 words or less);
- A list of five publications referenced to the description above; and
- A short curriculum vitae.

Nominations are made in two categories: excellence in clinical/translational oncology and in basic science cancer research. Please indicate on your form the category of your nomination. Nominations will be reviewed by AICF's Scientific Advisory Board in Spring 2018.

You may nominate up to three individuals. Please submit a separate form for each individual. Nominations must be received on or before February 28, 2018 at 11:59 PM EST. Submissions need to be sent in both electronic and hard copy to Cristina Aibino at:
