2021 Prize for Scientific Excellence in Medicine

Dear Friend,

The American-Italian Cancer Foundation (AICF) invites you to nominate a candidate for the 2021 **Prize for Scientific Excellence in Medicine**. The Prize has been established to recognize important discoveries in cancer biology, prevention, diagnosis and/or treatment. Two awardees will be selected and each presented with a \$50,000 prize at AICF's 2021 Benefit Dinner & Auctions in New York.

Please note that the 2020 Prize for Scientific Excellence in Medicine was not awarded because of the cancellation of AICF's 2020 Annual Benefit Dinner & Auctions due to the current pandemic. Nominations received in 2020 will be considered for the 2021 Prize. **The 2021 Prize will be awarded only if the Annual Benefit Dinner & Auctions will be held in person in November 2021 in New York.** The Prize winners are then required to give a lecture on their research at a symposium which is held the day following the Benefit.

The nomination form is enclosed. Each submission should include:

- A brief description of the discovery or discoveries on which the nomination is based (500 words or less)
- A list of five publications referenced to the description above
- A short curriculum vitae.

Please note that nominators and nominees cannot work for the same institution. Nominations are made in two categories: excellence in clinical/translational oncology and in basic science cancer research. Kindly indicate on your form the category of your nomination. Nominations will be reviewed by AICF's Scientific Advisory Board in Spring 2021.

You may nominate up to three individuals. Please submit a separate form for each individual. Nominations must be received on or before February 28, 2021 at 11:59 PM EST. Submissions need to be sent via email to Executive Director Cristina Aibino at caibino@americanitaliancancer.org
