## 2023 Prize for Scientific Excellence in Medicine

Dear Friend,

The American-Italian Cancer Foundation (AICF) invites you to nominate a candidate for the 2023 **Prize for Scientific Excellence in Medicine**. The Prize has been established to recognize important discoveries in cancer biology, prevention, diagnosis and/or treatment. Two awardees will be selected and each presented with a \$50,000 prize at AICF's 2023 Benefit Dinner & Auctions in New York.

Nominations are made in two categories: excellence in clinical/translational oncology and in basic science cancer research, and **must be based on significant contributions made by the nominees in the past 5 years**. Please note that nominators and nominees cannot work for the same institution.

The Prize winners are then required to give a lecture on their research at a symposium which is held the day following the Benefit.

The nomination form is enclosed. Each submission should include:

- A brief description of the discovery or discoveries on which the nomination is based (500 words or less)
- A list of five publications referenced to the description above
- A short curriculum vitae

You may nominate up to three individuals. Please submit a separate form for each individual. Nominations must be received **on or before March 28, 2023 at 11:59 PM EST**.
